## **Covid Update**

The Victorian Government has announced new arrangements for schools in Victoria from 11.59pm Wednesday 14 July.

School staff and secondary school students aged 12 or older must carry a face mask at all times, unless a lawful exception applies. Face masks must be worn outdoors where physical distancing of 1.5m cannot be maintained. Children under 12 years of age and students at primary school are not required to wear face masks when at school. This includes travelling to and from school on public transport or in a vehicle with others not from your household. For the purpose of communication, teachers and education support staff are not required to wear face masks while teaching, but those who wish to do so, can.

## Circus Arts - Uncaged Spirit





## Head Lice—Please be vigilant

## Tell head lice to nick off!

## **How to control** head lice


- Detect
  Use metal comb and combing solution to detect and remove head lice and their eggs

- Prevent
  Use egg remover and a metal comb to kill eggs and remove them from the head
- Repeat
  Repeat the process after 7 days
  to effectively kill the cycle
- Clean
  Wash bed linen and clothes in
  warm water with soaking solution
  to get rid of lice from home

## How to identify head lice

- Head lice can be anything from greyish white to white in colour
- They are the size of a sesame seed
- Nits are the eggs, yellowish white in colour and are found on the hair shaft generally at the nape of the neck

- It takes several weeks exposure to the lice before itching develops
- Head lice has nothing to do with hygiene
- Head lice don't like short and plaited hair
- The lice don't hop, jump or fly
- Don't share hats, head bands


## FIRST AID TRAINING
