# **Assistant Principals message:**

## Welcome back to Term 3

It has been fantastic to see the students return to school in such a positive way. The staff and students are adhering to the current Covid 19 guidelines. Staff within each room have implemented Covid 19 guidelines in the rooms such as hand hygiene, hand washing, sanitizing and social distancing. # **Student Support Group Meetings**

Due to current Covid 19 guidelines we will not be holding the student support group meetings onsite on the 31<sup>st</sup> of July as proposed. Students will now attend school on Friday 31<sup>st</sup> of July. In place of the SSG's parents can request a phone conversation if required. An important part of the SSG process is reviewing and updating the Individual Learning Plan. ### Transition and move to Twin Rivers School

In consultation with school council, staff and students we have planned a transition to the new school site. All students will visit the school and will spend a session in the new spaces prior to the formal move. During these sessions students will complete a walk through, discuss the spaces and become familiar with the surroundings. The transition week will be week 4 of this term. This will consist of Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> of August (pupil free) and 4<sup>th</sup>- 6<sup>th</sup> (transition visits) and Friday 7<sup>th</sup> of August (pupil free). The classroom teachers will provide information regarding which students will visit on which day.

#### **Bus**




