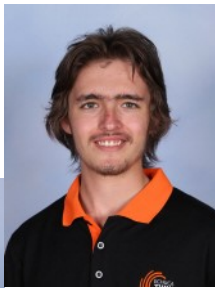
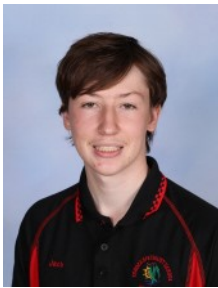
Transition Sessions
