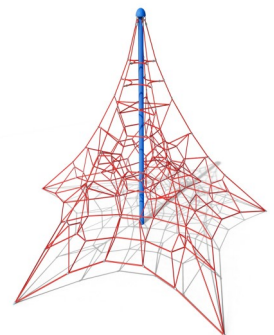

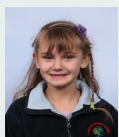
Dress: Semi-Formal
